






ORIENTATION & BEYOND: A REPORT ON THE CERTIFICATE COURSE ON 21ST CENTURY SKILLS FOR IN-SERVICE AND PRE-SERVICE TEACHERS

In order to match up with the SDG Alignment of inclusive and quality education by Experiencing Lifelong Learning and the challenges of 21st century, Symbiosis Law School Pune, (SLS Pune), a constituent of Symbiosis International (Deemed University) (SIU), as key partner, floated the project, "Teacher training with specialization on life and information technology skills" (also known as "21st Teach Skills"), with the purpose to carry forward the concept of 21st Century Skills – to establish an indispensable mark on the education system of India.



The rapid technological advancements and new patterns of work have compelled to encapsulate 21st century skills in the education of India. To meet the required skillset of the present times, it is required for teachers to be trained and, the skills need to be integrated into the teacher educational programs for honing the efficiency of teachers and enabling them to effectively impart and transfer the 21st century skills among students.

Keeping in line with this requirement, the module on Critical Thinking Skills and Collaborative Problem-Solving Skills was developed by SLS Pune and was offered as a "Certificate Program on 21st Century Skills" from October 2023 to January 2024 to preservice and in-service teachers as per the project requirements of pilot study. Critical Thinking as a skill is vital throughout one's professional life and is therefore a part of lifelong learning.

An orientation session in hybrid mode for the same was organized by Symbiosis Law School, Pune on 21st October 2023, which focused on acquainting the participants with the objectives of the project, content of course along with the deliverables.

The orientation session commenced with welcoming the participants (online and offline). Following this, the participants were acquainted with the objectives of the project along with the relevance of 21st-century teaching skills in the current scenario. Prof. Dr. Shashikala Gurpur, Director, Symbiosis Law School, Pune, and Dean, Faculty of Law, Symbiosis International (Deemed University) delivered the inaugural address. Her address helped participants to orient themselves with the importance of project deliverables which emphasized on the development of curriculum, by collaborating with in-service teachers and pre-service teachers.

Further, team of SCES/SLS Pune took the participants through the project journey and told them about the development of the 4 modules by the participating HEIs. She informed the participants about the 4 modules that were developed namely on 'Teaching Critical Thinking and Collaborative Problem-Solving Skills', 'Education Technology Skills', 'Authentic Learning Tasks', and 'Optimizing Assessment for 21st Century Skills'.

She stressed on the importance of the proposed certificate program which aligns with the United Nation's SDGs (Sustainable Development Goals), UNESCO's International Bureau of Education Framework, National Education Policy of India, WHOs 10 core life skills OECD

- Receipt of certificates
























































Thus, the 21st Teach Skills Course reverberated promise and hope for stakeholders beyond orientation.
