- 2. Substantive Events were held on 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> October 2022

## 1. Formal Events (10<sup>th</sup> October 2022 – 10 am to 6 pm IST – 8 Hours)

The networking events of 10<sup>th</sup> October 2022 were planned at two different venues. One was prelunch and lunch at Symbiosis Campus, Senapati Bapat Road, Pune and the other was post lunch at the Lavale Campus of SIU. The same are further demarcated as A and B below:

- A. Networking of Delegates with the Top Management, with the press members, with Directors of various institutes and officials of Symbiosis International (Deemed University) (SIU) followed by Networking Lunch organized at Symbiosis Campus, Senapati Bapat Road, Pune
- B. Visit to Lavale campus of SIU, meeting the team from Symbiosis Institute of Media and Communication (SIMC), the MOOC recording studio, and the Convention Hall for a presentation on biodiversity of the SIU, Lavale Campus.
- A. Networking with Top Management, Press and Director of various Institutes
  - (i) Networking with the Delegates and the Top Management of SIU
  - (ii) Press Conference
  - (iii) Networking of the Delegates with other SIU Team at Lavale
  - (i) Networking with the Delegates and the Top Management of SIU

On Day 1, as per the schedule, there was a networking event organized by Symbiosis Law School, Pune as the host institution for the delegates from the various partner institutions to meet and





interact with the Top Management of Symbiosis International (Deemed University). The networking event was attended by Dr. Vidya Yeravdekar, Principal Director, Symbiosis and Pro- Chancellor, SIU, Dr. Bhama Venkataramani, Dean, Academics, SIU, Dr. Sophia Gaikwad, Head, Teaching Learning Resource Center of SIU.

Prof. (Dr.) Shashikala Gurpur, Director, Symbiosis Law School, Pune, Dean, Faculty of Law, SIU, delivered the welcome address, emphasising on the significance of the project in present times and the need to equip the new generation with the skills required to meet present and future endeavours. She spoke on the growth of Symbiosis as an institution and in spearheading initiatives such as the 21<sup>st</sup> Teach Skills project. Dr. Gurpur commended the indomitable will and spirit of all stakeholders that pushed this project through the turbulent times brought upon by the pandemic.

After a short film on the evolution of Symbiosis, Dr. Vidya Yeravdekar, the Pro-Chancellor of Symbiosis International (Deemed University) introduced the University to the Participants from the partner institutions further emphasizing how the project through its multi- country consortium aims at strengthening and refining international bonding and understanding. The participants were introduced to the various initiatives undertaken by the University such as providing free healthcare in nearby villages of the SIU, Lavale campus and providing education to eight girl children from each village. She also informed about the aim of SIU to prepare its students to gain global competencies and introducing students to cultural and educational diversification of the stakeholders.

The address by Dr. Yeravdekar was followed by the address by Prof. Katerina Plakitsi, the Project leader from the University of Ioannina, Greece, who joined the networking meeting online from Greece. Her address started with a short video introducing the University of Ioannina to all. She stressed the importance of a homogenisation of good educational practices between Europe and Asia symbolizing the very idea of international cooperation and understanding. She also discussed the aims of the project and reaffirmed her optimism for the initiative, stressing its role in enhancement and enrichment of life and career skills of all stakeholders involved.

The forum deliberated on the shortcomings of the current curriculum and its level of inclusivity, which concluded with a unanimous call for better structuring and systematization of the curriculum to facilitate a more adaptive teaching-learning system.

## (ii) Press Conference

A press conference was organized to introduce the 21<sup>st</sup> TS project initiatives, its goals and the activities planned under the project where over 15 reporters and journalists from leading newspapers and Television channels participated. An excellent press coverage ensured that the project goals were brought out to the general public.

The press spoke to the project team members to understand the project and its implications.

During the press conference it was informed by Dr Vidya Yeravdekar that the project is truly international and focuses on imparting 21st century skills by training the teachers who in turn will train the students. In a globalized world where we don't know where our students are going to be working or what jobs they would be engaged in it is very important to train our teachers and through them the students. It was emphasised that digitalisation has impacted the world to a very great extent. We need to train our students to work in teams, in different situations. It was also informed that in Symbiosis we have a teaching Learning Resource Centre. During the networking Dr. Gurpur gave a detailed presentation of the project and informed that Symbiosis International ( Deemed University ) is one of the project partners- there are 9 partners- 3 from EU and 6 from Asia. It was informed that at this point we are in the process of developing the educational programme and training of learners. Dr. Marios from Novel group informed that this project was a unique opportunity for countries to work together.

Dr. Katerina during the networking introduced the University of Ioannina, Greece to all the participants. She spoke briefly about the 21st TS and the work packages under the project. She informed that the project covers 4 broad areas

- (i) Life and Career skills
- (ii) Learning and innovative skills
- (iii) Integration of global awareness
- (iv) Information and Media technology skills

During the networking event the Press was curious to know about the detailed findings of the project in India.

It was informed that the project began in the beginning of 2020. That the project relates to diverse needs, diverse nationalities, and different universities.

The Symbiosis International University, (SIU) India team has conducted doctrinal (Desk) research as well as non-doctrinal research to assess the overall teachers training requirements and the current student learning environment in India.

Some of the findings of doctrinal study which were presented by Dr. Gurpur were:

• Types of schools in India: Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE); Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE) / Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE);





International Baccalaureate (IB); International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE); and State Boards.

- CBSE Schools: In India 22660; In Maharashtra 1041; In Pune 187; and In Sangli 21
- ICSE Schools: In India 2542; In Maharashtra 245; In Pune 45; and In Sangli 1
- IB Schools: In India 176; In Maharashtra 42; In Pune 9; and In Sangli 0
- IGCSE Schools: In India 496; In Maharashtra 139; In Pune 7; and In Sangli 0
- Maharashtra State Board Schools: 20160

For the field survey, an extensive needs analysis was undertaken of the teachers, students and academic staff. Based on convenience and access, the sample was drawn from the different schools within Pune and Sangli. Out of the 10 schools surveyed, 1 was International Board School, 4 were National Board Schools and 5 were Maharashtra Board Schools. This survey was carried out with the help of extensive questionnaires drawn in English and Marathi language on Teaching and learning skills. A separate set of questionnaires was drawn for Teachers and Students. A total of 15 Administrative Staff, 125 teachers and 284 students answered these questionnaires.

In addition, experts from different partner institutions were consulted and they deliberated and contributed to the discussions and their efforts led to the preparation of the syllabus.

Some of the important findings of the survey were:

- The practice of imparting skills in general and 21 century skills in particular, is not structured and systematic, except in the case of Information Technology skills and collaboration skills.
- There are some outliers such as Kaveri Gifted Education and Research Centre, Robotics or the Tinkering lab for children in Symbiosis Schools who perform exceptionally well in academics, scholarship exams, artistic work, debate, innovations etc.
- The IB schools have a more structured approach and curriculum on thinking skills, but such schools are very few in comparison to the schools following state boards and national boards.
- · Cross cultural skills and collaboration are imparted only in a few institutions to students
- Life and career skills, overall development of students, leadership skills, self-motivation skills are imparted but not in a structured way in the schools.
- Student Centric incremental learning with structured course and measurement is not happening in Maharashtra. Wherever it exists, it exists by the management and teacher initiative as piecemeal dispersed diverse voluntary teacher-driven initiative.
- Teachers are aware about the 21<sup>st</sup> Century skills but were not trained while pursuing their degree in Education or in service
- By June 2020 there was a CBSE Handbook but not made mandatory for training the teachers
- Attainment levels are not assessed
- · No clear technology facilitation or collaboration or augmented science learning

Thus, there is a need for undertaking reforms in curriculum, mode of assessment, the method of imparting instructions and training the teachers to enable them to impart 21st century skills in a structured and meaningful way and also to meet the objectives laid down under the National Education Policy, (NEP, 2020) passed by the Indian Central Government. There is a need for revision





in the existing teachers training curriculum to include necessary flexibility and adaptability in regard to the level of learners. The skills must reach all and not only few.

The members of the press also wanted to know about the teaching aids and teaching methods. Dr. Vidya Yeravdekar and Dr. Gurpur informed that this project addresses the issues. When teachers are recruited to teach in IHE their qualification and PhD degree is considered and they are not aware of any teaching skills. Under the 21st TS the project is trying to ensure teaching skills amongst teachers. It was informed that at Symbiosis International (Deemed University) the Symbiosis Teaching and Learning Resource Centre (STLRC) has developed higher education andragogy which is also open to outsiders. There is a constant upgradation of skills for the teachers at Symbiosis. However, through the 21st TS project the teaching skills are expected to be improved. During the pilot study teachers were asked if they were aware of collaborative teaching, team work, and communication skills. 21st Teach Skills are still not part of B.Ed. programmes. The detailed survey administered through questionnaires helped identify the gaps and how to plug the gaps and how good courses can be made to train in-service and B.Ed. teachers and also create labs through which the training to the teachers can be provided. The survey found that there is a need to upgrade collaborative skills, problem solving skills and digital skills.

It was informed that study material is almost prepared and that partner institutions are going to provide pilot training. The project aims at imparting knowledge and motivating teachers to impart it in the classrooms.

The press also wanted to know how teachers are appointed in foreign universities and Europe.

Partners from Greece informed that the situation is similar like in India where a PhD degree is required to teach in Institutions of Higher Education. In Cambodia a Master's degree is sufficient to teach in Institutions of Higher Education and there is a national level test conducted as eligibility criteria.

During the Networking with the press, it was also told by the press that for a long time there has been a demand in India that there should be a basic programme that teaches teachers skill in teaching and the press wanted to know if there is a similar requirement in the partner countries too. Eleni from Greece responded in affirmative that they also felt the need for 21st Century skills to be taught to teachers.

Dr. Gurpur informed that a stratified sampling method was conducted in different schools with a purposive approach. The aim was not to find the exact number but to see whether the 21st Century skills were there and used in the teaching learning process. She mentioned that during a recent visit to a zilla parishad school it was found that due to local intervention there was the highest IT integration comparable to what is seen in an IB school- so it is not possible to go by the Board alone to draw a conclusion but the leadership, initiatives and teachers initiative play a big role in implementation of the skills to the students.

On the question of the process followed in the project it was informed by Dr. Gurpur and Dr. Katarina that project reports are periodically sent to the European Commission. It was informed that 4 modules have been developed by the partner institutions and training will be provided in the labs that have been created through the project funding and that online teaching will also be provided.





Dr. Gurpur informed that there would be another networking event on the 12th October where there would be a pilot study that would also be conducted where there would be a dissemination of teaching for teachers from both inservice and BEd programmes. It was also informed how Symbiosis law School Pune is the leader for preparing Module I where it has prepared the module with 400 hours of teaching and equal hours of learning by doing and homework. For preparing this module the expertise of about 20 persons including a Stanford expert, experts from International School were engaged.

It was informed that all reports to the European Commission was based on the needs analysis and that at the end of the project the team would be presenting a final report.

Dr. Surana from Banasthali University informed the press that training would be provided to teachers from all 28th States in the country and there will be a dissemination to teachers from all over.

It was also informed that the gaps identified through the survey was addressed in the syllabus prepared and that there will be recommendations made to the government to incorporate the same by the UGC. The NEP for the 1st time speaks about 21st Century skills. In the CBSE there is a small module that has been prepared on 21st Century teaching skills. We will be motivating the teachers to use 21st century Teaching skillsin their teaching and assessment and in extra-curricular activities and in teaching music and dance. There are students who learn through different methods and mediums and the teachers will be motivated to use different methods so that the teaching is translated well into learning.

Dr. Katarina who is the project leader informed that through this project there will be an exchange of good practices between Asia and Europe. These will be integrated through the project. This will include old traditions from Asia being transferred to Europe and likewise from Europe to Asia.

# Relevance of 21st Century Teach Skills in India- Regional Perspective - IAS Ayush Prasad — Zilla Parishad CEO, Pune

Further the delegates were introduced to Dr. K. Parameswaran, an Associate Professor and Former Dean of Law, GNLU, who had connected online to interact with the delegates, and who has special competence in teaching Values and Ethics as components of 21st TS.. He stressed that as a teacher, trainer or disseminator of knowledge, three things should be kept in mind:

- 1. Age of information to be merged with the age of inspiration;
- 2. Merge visible technology with invisible transformation;
- 3. Move from individualism to collectivism.

Dr. Parameswaran laid emphasis on 'Ethics' being universal, explicating its governing principles as follows:

- 1. The Principle of No Harm to individuals, animate and inanimate objects, sustainability, etc.
- 2. Connecting all dots
- 3. Ethics bring continuity.

Dr. Pranav Vashist, an independent researcher on the Dharmashastra (ancient Indian body of jurisprudence) and the Constitution of India, interacted with the delegates online and enlightened the gathering on how Philosophy translated roughly to Darsana during the Workshop on Indian Philosophy. He spoke about Matyasta Darsana and then moved to the four stages of learning comprising of Adhiti – Learning for one's own self, Bodha – Teaching it to someone else, Acarana – Practice of what is understood and Pracarana – Preaching it to people. He also elaborated on the





four quarters in the way of learning: students learn from Instructor, grasping by inherent ability to learn, interacting with peers and learning with experience.

#### Networking with teachers and students at Kaveri Group of Institutes (Time: 3 hours)

The delegates were then taken to the Kaveri Group of Institutes where Mrs. Malati Kalmadi, Dr. Devsena, Prof. Pallavi Naik, Prof. Pallavi Iyer, and Priya Atre made presentations which introduced the delegates to the institution and also the teaching pedagogy followed at the Kaveri Group of Institutes. The Gifted Centre programme followed at the school was explained in depth. An exclusive initiative of the school, it was explained that the programme now goes with the curriculum itself.

# International Conference cum Networking Event on 21st Century Skills for Teachers Brief Report

An International Conference-cum-Networking Event on 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills for Teachers was held at School of Education, Banasthali Vidyapith, India on 26<sup>th</sup> November 2023. This was a part of the ongoing Project on 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills for teachers. The event witnessed a huge participation of more than 200 participants from all over India and from other countries, mainly from the European Union, Cambodia and China. The Conference was held in hybrid mode, where some participants were present physically while others joined online.







In the Inaugural session of the Conference, Dr. Ajay Surana, Head, Department of Education, presented an overview of the Project and the Conference. Prof. Ina Shastri, Vice Chancellor, Banasthali Vidyapith delivered the Welcome Address. Prof. Manas Ranjan Panigrahi, Pro Vice Chancellor, Sangam University, India, in his key-note address, highlighted the importance of 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills for teachers in this era of globalization and digitization where the aim of equity and inclusion is gaining prominence.



The Chief Guest of the day, Prof. Alkaterini Plakitsi, Member of Governing Council, University of Ioannina, Greece in her address congratulated the Banasthali Vidyapith for their contribution to the Project. Dr Anna Batistatou, Director, University of Ioannina, Greece, who joined the Conference online, also appreciated the efforts of Project team of Banasthali Vidyapith. In the end, Prof. Anshuman Shastri, Director, Centre for Artificial Intelligence and International Relationship, Banasthali Vidyapith proposed the vote of thanks.









**Technical Session 1** of the Conference was on the broad theme: "21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills – Concept, Characteristics and Elements." The session was chaired by Prof. Alkaterini Plakitsi, University of Ioannina, Greece and co-chaired by Dr. Athina Christina Kornelaki from the same University. The Session Moderator was Dr. Sapna Sharma, Banasthali Vidyapith, India and Dr. Purnima Gupta, also from Banasthali Vidyapith, was the Session Reporter. A total of 11 papers were presented in the session.

Of the 11 papers presented in the Session, a few were of theoretical nature, emphasizing the need and importance of 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills for Teachers in the modern scenario, elaborating at length the concept, characteristics and categories and sub categories of these skills. Dr. Vandana Talegaonkar and Dr. Minaxi Shivdas Bhagwat, presented a research-based paper in which they shared the findings of research to investigate the dichotomy between Robot Teachers and Human Teachers and explored implications for educators' professional development, aligning with the demands of 21st-century skills, within the context of Al-mediated teaching-learning paradigms. Kritika Garg and Dr. Pritam Pyari, in their paper, explored the theoretical foundations of incorporating gamified elements into traditional educational approaches and the possibility of this integration in enhancing the acquisition of essential skills required in the 21st century.





Mr Vinod Kumar Velayudhan Nair and Dr. Ajay Surana in their research paper explored the possibility of developing 21st Century Skills through Physics Teaching while Ms Neha et al in their paper aimed at achieving this through IDLP. Ms Ranu Mondal asserted that validity and fairness of 21st century skills assessments could foster a more equitable and inclusive educational environment.

The Session was summed up by Dr. Athina Christina Kornelaki, who commented that we all understand the concepts related to 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills and the need to develop them; what is needed is an exploration of the strategies, the methods; the ways and means to develop these skills and equip all learners at the grass root level. Prof. Aikaterini Plakitsi thanked the organizers and all the paper presenters and expressed a hope that more such deliberations would be held in future to make Education more equitable and inclusive and more meaningful in the fast changing scenario of the present world.



**The technical session 2** of the International Conference catered to the theme: "Strategies, Methods and Tools to develop 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills" The session was chaired by Professor Sam Rany, National University of Battambang, Cambodia. Dr. Aparajita Mohanty from Symbiosis International University co-chaired the session. The session moderator was Dr. Shilpi Purohit, Banasthali Vidyapith, India and the session reporter was Mrs. Ranu Mondal from Banasthali Vidyapith. A total 12 research papers were presented in the session.





Dr. Ruchi Bhargava presented a research paper on Emerging trends on e-learning to develop 21<sup>st</sup> century skills with special reference to Diksha digital platform. Dr. Ajay Krishna Tiwari, in his paper, examined the need for competency-based skill education in Science education. Dr. Prem Singh Sikarwar discussed the importance of skill development in the global educational scenario. Dr. Neeti Trivedi probed into the possibility of developing 21<sup>st</sup> century skills among students through activities. Ms. Neha Sharma and Dr. Purnima Gupta discussed the need and the strategies to develop 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills for Teachers of differently-abled children. Ms. Nilofar brought out the need to bridge the skill gap of Indian students. Ms. Ritu identified challenges faced in skill developed and discussed means to overcome these challenges while Dr. Amit Kumar discussed skill development in relation to NEP 2020. Dr. Mallika Shekhar and Ms. Nisha Gurjar discussed the importance of enhancing 21st Century Skills. Dr. Mahesh Kumar Gangal and Niddhi Bachheti presented a research article on strategies to develop 21<sup>st</sup> century teachers' skills while Dr. Neha Malhotra and Dr. Babita B. Mohanty focused on the use of blended learning approach for this. Dr. Arpana Tripathi brought out the need of nurturing 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills for Holistic Development in students.



The session was concluded by Professor Aparajita Mohanty, who pointed out that the presenters should also emphasize on the strategies which can be implemented in the classroom for fostering 21<sup>st</sup> century skills. She also suggested that some real life examples could have been included in the papers. Prof. Sam Rany suggested that appropriate objectives of research,





methodology used to investigate the objectives and references and citation must also be included in the research papers. In the end, Dr. Shilpi Purohit conveyed the vote of thanks.

## Technical Session 3: Role of Teachers to promote 21<sup>st</sup> Century skills and Assessment of these skills.

The third technical session focused on sub theme "Role of Teachers to promote 21<sup>st</sup> Century skills and Assessment of 21<sup>st</sup> Century skills". This session was chaired by Prof. Manas Ranjan Panigrahi, Pro Vice Chancellor, Sangam University, India. The session co-chair was Dr. Samhang Chea, Royal University of Phnom Penh, Combodia, Session moderator was Dr. Murlidhar Mishra, Banasthali Vidyapith, India and session reporter was Dr. Preetam Pyari, Banasthali Vidyapith, India.

Under this subtheme total of 13 papers were presented. Of these, 09 papers were based on the Role of Teachers in promoting 21<sup>st</sup> Century skills, 3 were related to Assessment of 21<sup>st</sup> Century skills while Nidhi Goel and Dr. Shilpi Purohit presented an analysis of NEP, 2020 in relation to the 21<sup>st</sup> Century skills

Mrs. Anjini Kumari Soni & Ms. Himanshi emphasized on the need of teachers in 21st Century to think globally with an open mind, to develop sensitivity, understand culture, technology engagement etc. They also talked about difference between 21st Century and traditional skills. Ms. Pawanpreet Kaur pointed out that the 21st Century teacher should develop teaching strategies, personalized instruction, project based learning, learning environment according to needs of students. Dr. Dinesh Kumar Gupta focused on professional relationship of teacher with students, qualities of teachers, and development of technological skills in teachers to promote effective learning while Dr. Anil Babu talked flipped classroom, blended learning and retention of learning. Ms. Ayushi Singh and Prof. Kavita Mittal maintained that teachers have to think out of the box. Ms. Iti Pandey and Dr. Ajay Surana talked about 21st Century skills, role of teacher as control, promoter, resource, assessor, organizer etc. Dr. P. Ramya, Dr. T. Parimelan and Dr. V. Siva Guru Vignesh focused on the need for teachers to become techno savvy and student to be prepared for techno savvy employment. Ms. Shabnam discussed about constitutional values and how 21st century skills can be developed by teachers through constitutional values. Ms. Akanksha Mishra and Ms. Diksha Kumari discussed about digital literacy, role of teacher as organizer, instruction, tutor, controller etc. integration of technology in teaching.

Dr. Y. Vijiya Lakshmi and Mr. Afzal Ahmad presented paper on ICT tools usage and expertise among elementary school teachers and concluded that location of school and educational qualifications of teachers have a significant influence on teachers and expertise of using ICT tools. Ms. Garima Verma & Dr. Ajay Surana talked about challenges of assessment in 21st Century such as complex thinking, difficult to express etc. while Ms. Asiya Sultana and Prof.





Siddiqui Mohd. Mahmood emphasized on the need to increase retention rate through the use of graphic organizers, mind maps, visual learning modules, IWB (Interactive White Board) and technology, storytelling, multimedia etc.



The session was summed up by Prof. Manas Ranjan Panigrahi who through his encouraging words, gave a ray of hope to all and said that India is moving towards inclusion; there has been a positive shift among teachers and learners in terms of use of technology, teachers are quickly embracing their new roles but also pointed out that we still have a long way to go. In the end, Dr. Murlidhar Mishra extended the vote of thanks.


The three technical sessions were very enlightening and gave a lot of food for thought.







